**Talk:** Study the reading and consider the background.

He fell to the ground and heard a voice saying to him, "Saul, Saul, why do you persecute me?" 5 He asked, "Who are you, Lord?" The reply came, "I am Jesus, whom you are persecuting. (Acts 9:4-5)

Saul is one of the best-known—and feared—persecutors of the fledgling Christian church. If there's anyone who knows, without a doubt, what he stands for and what he's about, it's Saul. Surely such a man couldn't be thwarted by one unsettling journey?

- ⇒ Tell of a time you thought you were headed in one direction, and then life threw you a curveball, and you found yourself headed in an entirely different direction.
- ⇒ What would you have done if you had been Ananias, called to go straight to a man known to persecute and kill Christians?
- ⇒ God opened Saul's eyes and helped Ananias see Saul differently. Who are people or situations God is calling you to see differently?
