Read: Read the following from worship on Sunday:

1 John 4:11-19, Luke 10:25-37 (Connected to God and others)



Talk: Study the reading and consider the background.

The greatest two greatest commandments are: "You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart, and with all your soul, and with all your strength, and with all your mind; and your neighbor as yourself." And Jesus says "You have given the right answer; do this, and you will live."

- ⇒How do you find life in your relationship with God?
- ⇒What can you do to grow in your relationship with God? The lawyer talking to Jesus and wanting to justify himself, he asked Jesus, "And who is my neighbor?" Jesus then proceeded to tell the parable of the Good Samaritan.
 - ⇒Who is your neighbor?
 - ⇒How can you love your neighbor?
